It is in the top 35% of all journals in the engineering / architecture category. JoDLA is listed in DOAJ (Directory of Open Access Journals).

The author's fee for the publication is currently 350 Euros for the standard 8 pages of print with the option of publishing extra pages at 50 Euros per additional page.
